Language and Literacy

Reading/comprehension – use of short novels and guided reading books.

Spelling – new spelling scheme in P6 (The Read Write Company). Spelling activities are also completed to complement the learning.

Creative Writing/Poetry – structure, interest, awareness of audience.

Grammar and Punctuation – parts of language and developing accuracy in use of punctuation in written work.

Talking and Listening – class, group and paired activities in both talking and listening.

Developing a more structured approach to activities (link with PowerPoints).



Mathematics and Numeracy

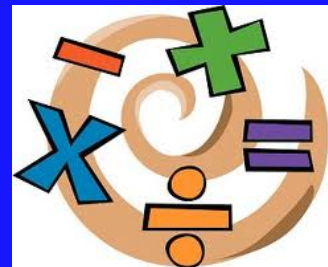
Processes – communicating mathematically, understanding mathematical language, develop different approaches to problem solving

Number – four operations, times tables, place value, fractions and money.

Shape and Space – properties of 2D and 3D shapes, lines and angles, compass and direction, co-ordinates

Data Handling – use of a range of tables and charts, probability

Measures – length, weight, capacity, area, perimeter, time (12 hour and 24 hour) and timetables



Using ICT

- Use of laptops, computers and a range of other digital technologies;
- Cross-curricular approach;
- New skills for P6 such as Microsoft Excel, using ICT skills to edit work, more independent research for relevant information, coding, sending and receiving e-mails;
- Focus on E-safety, both in school and at home.

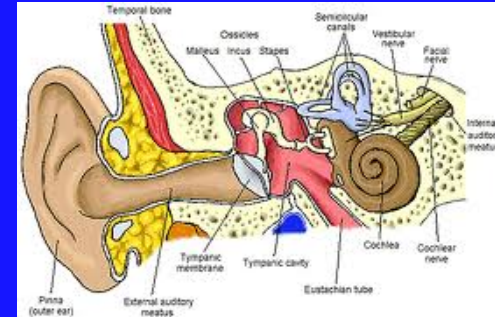

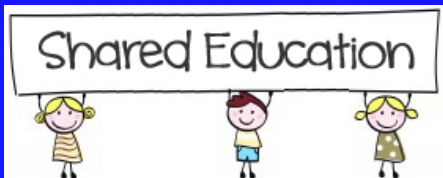
As always in P6, SEAG preparation will begin in Terms 2 and 3. We will keep you updated about this process as the year progresses.

Shared Education (SE)

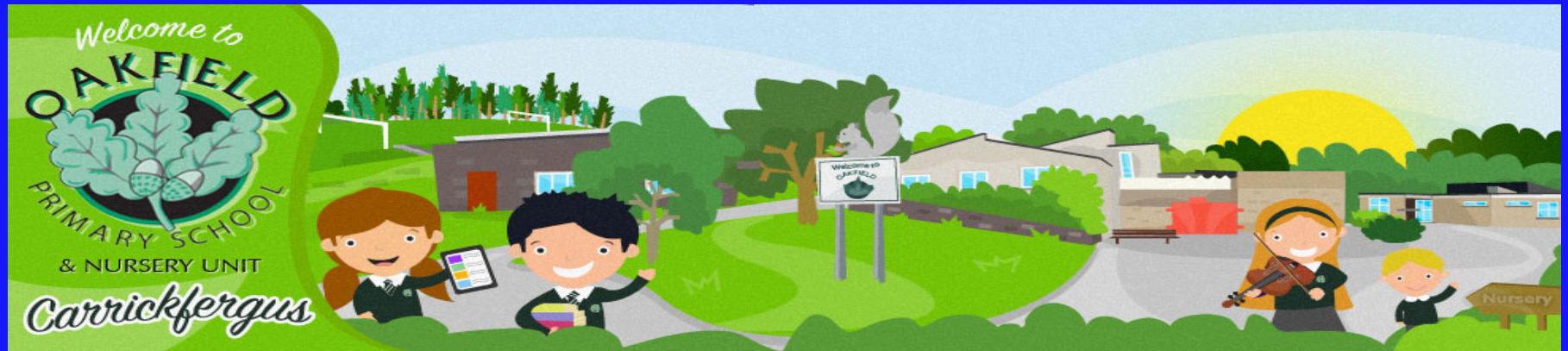
What is SE?

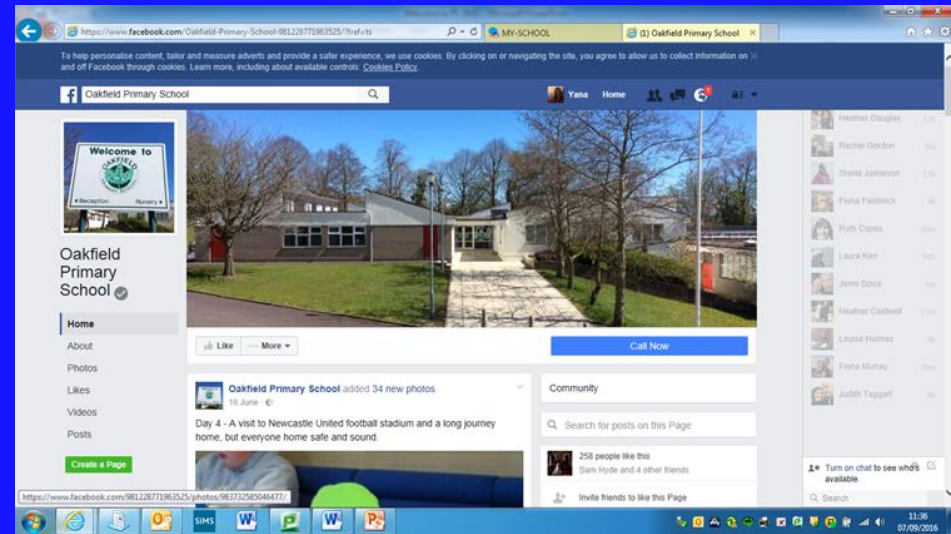
