Stay safe on YouTube using the instructions on restrict mode Filtering, Blocking & Reporting below.



### Turn on restricted mode filtering with these simple instructions;

- On your home screen tap on your profile picture in the top right corner.
- Scroll down and tap on (0)
- Swipe the tab to the right to activate Restricted Mode.

### Block

#### Block a user using these simple instructions;


- Underneath the user's video select their profile picture.
- On the user's profile select in the top right corner.
- Select Block user & then select Block again.

### Report a video using these simple instructions;

- Select the video you want to report and then tap
- Select on Report user.
- Select your reason for reporting that video and submit.

YouTube kids allows children and young people to watch their favourite videos in one place and they can search for the shows they like and discover new ones. It contains videos that are uploaded to YouTube and has an algorithm that pulls out appropriate videos for little ones.

### Parental Controls

#### Configure the Parental Controls with these simple instructions;

- Tap on finithe bottom right corner of the app & then complete the multiplication.
- Tap on Settings and then select your child's profile.
- Enter your password. Here you can configure content settings, allow searching and control watch history.

### **⊗**Blocking

#### Block a video using these simple instructions;

- Select the video you want to block and then tap on
- Tap on Block.
- You can chose from two options, Block this video only or Block entire channel.



#### Report a video using these simple instructions;

- Select the video you want to report and then tap on
- Select Report.
- Select your issue and then tap Report.
